CONDUCT OF THE 2022 MWSS REGULATORY OFFICE (RO) ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATION (APE)

In the interest of the service and pursuant to Civil Service Commission Resolution No. 33 dated December 22, 1997 which promulgates and adopts the policy that all government offices shall provide Annual Mental and Medical-Physical Examination, and Administrative Order No. 402, s. 1998, "Establishment of the Annual Medical Check-up Program", Section 1 thereof, stating that an annual medical check-up for government officials and employees is hereby authorized to be established starting 1998, the conduct of the 2022 APE is hereby approved.

I Coverage

All MWSS RO officials and employees whose names are listed in the Master List attached as **Annex** "**A**" are qualified to undergo laboratory and diagnostic procedures to be administered by the Best Diagnostic Corporation, attached as **Annex** "**B**".

II Venue and Schedule

The Onsite/Mobile Clinic based APE will be conducted on 13-14 October 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the MWSS RO Building, Lot 2 MWSS Compund, Katipunan Ave., Brgy. Pansol, District 3, Quezon City. The respective Regulation Area representatives to the Safety and Health Committee shall make a survey of your preferred APE schedule.

Qualified employees who may not be available on both dates can proceed to the Best Diagnostic Corporation clinic located at 94 Masikap Extension Brgy. Central, Diliman Quezon City within the two (2) month contract period or until 1 December 2022, subject to coordination with the Admin-HR.

III APE Package

Refer to the APE Package as indicated in attached Annex "B". Talents may avail of additional procedures not covered by the package, subject to the approval of the Administration Department and a one-time salary deduction to be applied on the succeeding payroll period once the APE results are released.

IV ROUTINE APE IN A DAY

- AM: Registration, Blood Extraction, Receiving, Whole Abdomen and Prostate Ultrasound, ECG and Chest X-ray
- PM: Breast Ultrasound, ECG, Chest X-ray, Vital Signs, Complete Physical Exam, Pap Smear

Patient Requirements:

- 1. Registration
 - Talents should bring their own ball pen for filling-out forms.
 - Talents should be at the venue preferably before 7:00 a.m. for the registration.
- 2. Blood Extraction
 - Talents should do fasting for 10-12 hours. Beyond the fasting period, talents should proceed to the other tests.
- 3. Receiving
 - For urinalysis, it should be midstream catch and should fill ³/₄ of the cup, while the Fecalysis specimen should be at least the size of the 25 centavo coin.
- 4. Ultrasound
 - For abdomen ultrasound, do fasting for 8-12 hours
 - For breast ultrasound, women are advised not to use deodorant on their scheduled date as this can affect the procedure.
- 5. Chest X-ray and ECG
 - Talents are advised to wear clothes with no collar, buttons. No metal accessories. Females are advised not to wear bras with metal.
- 6. Physical Examination
 - Talents will proceed to the assigned nurse for Vital Signs, after which they can proceed to the physical examination. Females above 40 years old will proceed to the Pap Smear test.
- 7. Return of APE Form:
 - Once the APE is completed, the APE form should be returned to the Registration Area.
 - If APE form is not returned, results will be put on hold

- 8. Results
 - Issuance of Laboratory Results will be submitted 10 days after the APE.
- 9. Medical Consultation/Interpretation of Results
 - A separate schedule for medical consultations will be made available to all who availed of the APE within the two (2) month contract period.
- 10. Confidentiality
 - The MWSS Regulatory Office and the Best Diagnostic Corporation shall maintain all medical results and other information in strict confidence and shall not disclose documents and information unless authorized by the Talent concerned.

This Office Order shall take effect immediately.

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- PHYSICAL EXAMINATION
- ROUTINE URINALYSIS
- BASIC OPTICAL EXAMINATION (VISUAL ACUITY VIEW)
- COMPLETE BLOOD COUNT WITH PLATELET
- CHEST X-RAY (PLAIN): POSTERIOR-ARTERIOR (PA) VIEW
- 12 LEAD ELECTROCARDIOGRAM (ECG)
- DENTAL EXAMINATION WITH CLEANING
- BLOOD TYPING
- MENTAL HEALTH ASSESMENT
- BLOOD CHEMISTRY to include: Fasting Blood Sugar (FBS), Total Cholesterol and Uric Acid Determination
- Liver Enzymes (SGPT and SGOT) and Lipid Profile (Triglycerides, HDL, LDL, VLDL), Blood Urea Nitrogen and Creatinine.
- Male above years old-Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) and Prostate Ultrasound
- Female above years old-Breast Ultrasound and Papsmear
- Fecalysis with Occult blood (Ova and parasites, amoeba).
- Abdominal ultrasound (liver, spleen, pancreas, adrenals, gall bladder, kidneys and urinary bladder)

ROUTINE OF APE IN A DAY:

- AM: REGISTRATION, BLOOD EXTRACTION, RECEIVING, WHOLE ABDOMEN AND PROSTATE ULTRASOUND, ECG, CHESTXRAY
- PM: *BREAST ULTRASOUND, **ECG, **CHEST XRAY, VITAL SIGNS, COMPLETE PHYSICAL EXAM, *PAP SMEAR

PATIENT REQUIREMENTS:

I. REGISTRATION:

- Employees who had schedule date for APE should bring their own ballpen for filling up forms.
- Employees should be at the venue before 7am for registration.

II. BLOODEXTRACTION:

- Employees should do FASTING for 10-12hrs. Beyond the fasting requirement, they can't be extracted and must proceed to other tests.
- Preferably, employees should wear blouse with short sleeves only or T-shirt.

III. RECEIVING:

- Employees must get their specimen cups for Urinalysis and Fecalysis if they can provide the specimen immediately.
- Specimen cups must have labels of the employee's name before collecting specimen.
- For Urinalysis, it should be midstream catch and should fill ¾ of the cup. While on Fecalysis, specimen should be at least the size of the .25centavo.

IV. ULTRASOUND:

- Employees with Whole Abdomen Ultrasound should do fasting for about8-12HRS.
- For Breast Ultrasound, women are advised not to have deodorant on their scheduled date as it can affect the procedure.

V. CHEST X-RAY and ECG:

- Employees are advised to not wear clothes with collar, buttons and with metal accessories (earrings, watch, etc.). Females are advised not to wear push-ups bra as it has metal on it.
- Preferably, wear light colored clothes on the upper body.

VI. PHYSICALEXAM:

 Employees will proceed to the assigned nurse for Vital Signs. After Vital Signs. Employees can proceed to physical exam after doing vitalsigns.Femalesage40yrs.oldandabovewillproceedtoPap Smear by Female Physician.

VII. RETURN OF APEFORM:

- If all employees are done, APE form should be RETURNED to the REGISTRATIONAREA.
- If APE Form is not return, results of the EMPLOYEE WILL BE PUT ONHOLD.

SUBMISSION OF RESULTS

- Results will be submitted 10 days after the APE.
