Violation shall result in MWSS RO resampling wherein the analytical cost of the samples collected shall be borne by the Contractor, including control samples, if any. Violation in excess of two (2) counts during the Contract period may result in the termination of the Contract.	6.5.2. A handling violation is considered to have occurred when the Contractor renders a sample unusable; or reports a sample that is rendered unacceptable for analyses in excess of the 6-hour requirement. Violation shall result in MWSS RO resampling wherein the analytical cost of the samples collected shall be borne by the Contractor, including control samples, if any. Two (2) violations during the Contract period may result in the termination of the Contract.

6.7.3.2. MWSS RO shall inform the Contractor of any special resampling request through telephone or email. The samples collected for this request shall be used for the imposition of penalty to the Concessionaires, thus, shall be prioritized and immediately analyzed.	
6.7.3.3. The Contractor shall, through email, provide the MWSS RO WQCD an "Advance Notification" as specified in Appendix B on samples that fail the PNSDW or any standard limits set by the MWSS RO for specific parameters.

If a bidder has a recently expired Mayor's/Business permit, bidders may check Section 23.1 a) ii) for alternatives in the updating of PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership).
